Old Business

- Egge’s went out week of 10/10 to look at patching North Prairie Lake Road – but informed by Driveway Services that it was too cold to put down tar so unable to proceed. Egge’s may be able to patch next week when it warms up. However, unsure if the road would be able to get second lift this fall. After discussion the Board said they don’t want the lift tried to be put down this year. Board is extremely disappointed that we’re in this position. Egge’s had promised this work done in the spring, then summer, then in a couple of weeks when questioned earlier– but it never happened. It doesn’t seem that the Township is considered a priority customer as this has dragged all the way into October and now it’s too cold. Hopefully the road will be finished next year, but the Board is extremely displeased with Egge’s management of the project.
- Continuing to work to update Township website – working with our vendor and the Federal Gov’t to see if we can get a .gov domain. Looks like PelicanOttertailMN.gov will be available for us. Will also sign up for two e-mail addresses, one for the clerk and treasurer.
