July 15th, 2025***

Old Business

- Still waiting on info for quotes on 180th Avenue and Prairie Lake Road.
- Drafted letter related to Shleske complaint and provided to County. Wayne Johnson spoke with Brady, wants something from an attorney, though he said that he had staff looking at the issue. Wants the Township to have cars removed from right-of-way, though that isn't the issue and others would also have to move vehicles. Will wait to see if County takes any action.
- Put up speed limit signs on Burr Oak Hills and on Prairie Lake Road. Contractors refused to put overlay on Burr Oak Hills; so Township will not officially allow a detour. Will put up barricades for local traffic only.
- Gravel and dust guard have been put down on roads. Price per foot is \$1.28. Will need to get a list together for invoicing private residences.
- Carr's was out spraying; seemed to do a good job and spot sprayed leafy spurge.

New Business

- Ken Lyden called and said that he'd like to have two back lots in the industrial park surveyed so that they can be put together. They presently have 99 year leases on them

but Ken wanted to know if the Township would have any issue if they changed and put a regular parcel together. No concerns from the Township, he'll need to do the legal work and then record with the County.

- Adopted resolution to assign any cannabis or edible hemp registration issues to the County.
- Discussed road maintenance with Billy Wells. Will need to grade dust guard spots and continue to work to pull in gravel from shoulders and maintain the crown on the roads.
- Filled a couple of pot holes on Prairie Lake Road. Put down tar patch to try to make it better.
